- Construct multi-shaped moulds and structures based on design information
- Set up, fit and install large parts, superstructures, bulkheads, decks etc.

- Set up and install all manner of ships hardware and outfitting, exterior glass, exterior watertight doors, handrails and steps
- Fabrication work including work with Stainless Steel, aluminum and steel.
