Job Description and Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee document control for the projects

- Work with production team leaders to support fabrication and/or installation of systems
- Consult with and include the production department in all designs to gain buy in and encourage collaboration between engineering and production

- Proven understanding and application of naval architecture and marine engineering theories and principles
