



Interior Designer

Job Type: Fixed-term, Full time; Available Immediately

This new role for interior designer will be an integrated player on our design team in delivering Canada's largest super yacht. The candidate will work directly with our Interior Department Manager from concept to completion through a variety of design, management, documentation and administration tasks. Candidate will require strong organizational and time management skills, with great attention to detail.

Job Description and Key Responsibilities: The Interior Designer will assist with all interior design aspects of the project including the creation of interior drawings in CAD, vendor liaison and the documentation of materials and finishes, and overall documentation of the project. Key responsibilities are as follows.

- Detailed interior CAD drawings 2D (AutoCAD ability essential)
- Review and detail shop drawings for construction
- Review details of technical drawings or specifications
- Create supporting documentation required in the Interior Design process such as: specifications documents and finish schedules
- Research and sourcing of new material's/fabrics/accessories, preparing client presentations, placing and tracking orders, meeting with vendors and updating/organizing sample library.
- Follow-up on all specification orders, communication between vendors
- Manage and track drawings
- Coordinate with other professionals - contractors, architects, engineers, plumbers and electricians
- Coordinate construction or installation activities
- Please note this is not a concept design role, but an opportunity to be part of delivering stunning yacht interiors.

Qualifications:

- 2-5 years of experience in interior design
- Knowledge of yacht interiors is an advantage but not essential
- Proficient in, AutoCAD (essential) and Rhino (is a benefit)
- Ability to work well under pressure, organize and prioritize multiple projects and adjust work accordingly, often against tight deadlines
- Possess strong verbal, written and visual communication skills with all levels of employees, management and outside parties
- Demonstrate creative abilities and applied problem-solving skills
- Strong abilities to work in a team setting and achieve results through collaboration and sharing
- Proven ability to self-manage and demonstrate high level of professional maturity
- Must be quality minded and self-motivated
